- 2. How many patients aged 0-2 years old (i.e. from birth until their 3rd birthday) were attended by a resource from Scottish Ambulance Service in the two years from 1st January 2022 until 31st December 2023?
- 3. How many patients aged 3-5 years old were attended by a resource from Scottish Ambulance Service in the two years from 1st January 2022 until 31st December 2023?
- 4. How many patients aged 6-11 years old were attended by a resource from Scottish Ambulance Service in the two years from 1st January 2022 until 31st December 2023?
- 5. How many patients aged 12-15 years old were attended by a resource from Scottish Ambulance Service in the two years from 1st January 2022 until 31st December 2023?
- 6. How many patients aged 16-17 years old were attended by a resource from Scottish Ambulance Service in the two years from 1st January 2022 until 31st December 2023?
- 7. How many patients aged 0-17 years old were conveyed by to an emergency department by a resource from Scottish Ambulance Service in the two years from 1st January 2022 until 31st December 2023?
